Thursday, April 28, 2011

A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held in Council Chambers of City Hall in Cody, Wyoming on Thursday, April 28, 2011 at 4:15 p.m.

Present: Mayor Nancy Tia Brown, Council Members Steve Miller, Bryan Edwards, Jerry Fritz, Donny Anderson, Charles Cloud and Stan Wolz, City Attorney, Scott Kolpitke, City Administrator, Jenni Rosencranse and Deputy Clerk, Cindy Baker.

Mayor Nancy Tia Brown called the meeting to order at 4:17 p.m.

General background information on the various Topsy-Taxi programs that are currently active in the State of Wyoming and surrounding states was presented by staff to the Governing Body. Council Members Fritz, Wolz and Anderson will be contacting the Park County Liquor Association, local liquor establishments, and the local cab company. Mayor Nancy Tia Brown will contact West Park Hospital. Staff was directed to research the possibility of something on utility bills in reference to indicating willingness to support the program. No action was taken.

James Klessans discussed with the Governing Body a project in reference to Cody Laboratories proposed expansion and coming to the Governing Body in the future requesting the City to participate in this project as required with the Wyoming Business Council. No action was taken.

The Governing Body reviewed the Council Agenda for May 3, 2011. No action was taken.

Council and Staff updates:

Council Member Cloud has received citizens' complaints about the garage sale signs, not really in reference to the posting, but not taking them down. Discussed having possibly directing staff, Community Service Officer, to on Monday's remove signs and visit with residents who held such sale. Residents would be provided a warning that future offenses could result in a ticket and fine. Discussion was also held on the situation at Juby's Mobile Home Park and it was suggested that there being a meeting with the stake holders that would include council, Chief of Police, fire department, and/or other entities. Staff was directed to organize a stake holder meeting.

Mayor Tia Brown informed the Governing Body she would be drafting a letter as a follow up to Canyon Avenue discussion.

Steve Payne, Public Works Director gave an update on the progress of Cougar Avenue and possible travel on the road this weekend, though it would be gravel, as it would be approximately two 2 weeks before asphalt plant up and running.
