Council Proceedings
Thursday, June 2, 2011

A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held in Council Chambers of City Hall in Cody, Wyoming on Thursday, June 2, 2011 at 4:15 p.m.

Present: Mayor Nancy Tia Brown, Council Members Steve Miller, Bryan Edwards, Donny Anderson, Charles Cloud, and Stan Wolz, City Attorney, Scott Kolpitcke, Public Works Director, Steve Payne and Administrative Services Officer, Cindy Baker. Council Member Jerry Fritz arrived at 5:32 p.m.

Absent: City Administrator, Jenni Rosencranse

Mayor Nancy Tia Brown called the meeting to order at 4:22 p.m.

Rick Manchester, Parks, Recreation & Facilities Director provided the Governing Body the planned activities for the 10 Year Anniversary of the Paul Stock Aquatic and Recreation Center, to be held on Friday, June 24th. No action was taken.

The Governing Body discussed changes to the proposed Ordinance 2011-07. An Ordinance amending section 10-15-6 of the Municipal Code by Providing General Provisions Regarding the Sign Code (regarding signage on Parked Vehicles). No action was taken.

The Governing Body discussed changes to the proposed Ordinance 2011-10. An Ordinance amending section 10-15-9 of the Municipal Code by Designating Commercial Sign Districts. No action was taken.

The Governing Body reviewed the Council Agenda for June 7, 2011. No action was taken.

Council Member Anderson informed the Governing Body of a citizen's interest in a community garden and inquired as to whether the City had any vacant property that could be utilized for such project.

Council Member Miller informed the Governing Body of the agenda for the annual Sheridan Avenue sidewalk washing event to talk place on Saturday, June 4th. Council Members Anderson and Wolz will be handing out flyers on Friday, June 3rd to affected merchants as a reminder of this event.

Rick Manchester, Parks, Recreation & Facilities Director informed the council that representatives from the mountain bike group were in town viewing the BLM site for the planned bike park. He also informed the group that over 1500 deer surveys had been received and inputted. There is a Deer Committee meeting scheduled on June 22nd to go over the results of this survey.

Steve Payne, Public Works Director, informed the Governing Body of the status of Cougar Avenue. Paving has been completed and the avenue should be open to traffic on Friday.

Council Member Miller made a motion, seconded by Council Member Cloud to enter into executive session pursuant to Wyoming State Statute 16-4-405 at 6:08 p.m. to discuss a personnel matter. Vote was unanimous. Council Member Miller made a motion seconded by Council Member Anderson to exit out of the executive session at 6:22 p.m. Vote was unanimous.

There being no further business to discuss, the Mayor adjourned the meeting at 6:23 p.m.
