A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held in Council Chambers of City Hall in Cody, Wyoming on Thursday, June 16, 2011 at 4:14 p.m.

Present: Mayor Nancy Tia Brown, Council Members Steve Miller, Bryan Edwards, Donny Anderson, Charles Cloud, Jerry Fritz, and Stan Wolz, City Administrator, Jenni Rosencranse, City Attorney, Scott Kolpitcke, and Administrative Services Officer, Cindy Baker.

Mayor Brown requested Council Member President Miller to conduct the meeting. Council President Miller called the meeting to order at 4:15 p.m.

ORDINANCE 2011-21 2nd Reading
AN ORDINANCE FOR THE AMOUNT OF TAX LEVY FOR THE CITY OF CODY, WYOMING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2012.
Council Member Fritz made a motion seconded by Council Member Wolz to approve Ordinance 2011-21 2nd reading. Vote was unanimous.

ORDINANCE 2011-20 2nd Reading
AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF MONEY FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY OF CODY, WYOMING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2012.
Council Member Fritz made a motion seconded by Council Member Anderson to approve Ordinance 2011-20 2nd reading. Vote was unanimous.

Council Member Edwards made a motion seconded by Council Member Anderson to approve and authorize the Mayor to sign Change Order No. 1 to Bid No 2011-05, 16th Street Storm Drainage Project in the amount of \$15,003.44. Vote was unanimous.

Council Member Edwards made a motion seconded by Council Member Cloud to approve and authorize the Mayor to sign the revised Change Order No. 3 Cody Auditorium ADA Renovation in the amount of \$615.00. Vote was unanimous.

The Governing Body discussed a Steering Committee for the Sheridan Avenue Project. Staff was directed to move forward with this committee.

The Governing Body discussed options regarding the easement on Platinum Avenue. Council's direction was to turn back the upkeep of the alley to the neighbors as per the City Ordinance pertaining to alleys adjoining such premises.

Council Member Fritz made a motion seconded by Council Member Edwards to approve naming the circle around the Buffalo Bill Statue to Coe Circle. Vote was unanimous.

After discussion on the intent of each committee, the Governing Body formed two committees. The Nuisance Committee will consist of Council Members Anderson, Cloud and Miller and the Liquor License Committee will consist of Council Members Edwards, Fritz and Wolz.

The Governing Body reviewed the Council Agenda for June 21, 2011. No action was taken.

Staff updates included information on the construction work at the intersection of Park Lane and Jack Skates Parkway and the Topsy Taxi program. The Governing Body was reminded of the Deer Task Force meeting June 22nd and the 10 Year Anniversary of the Recreation Center the week of June 20th.

Council updates included information on the Buffalo Bill Historical Center's continued conversations with the neighbors in reference to the zone change.

There being no further business to discuss, the Council President Miller adjourned the meeting at 5:58 p.m.
