Council Proceedings
Thursday, March 31, 2016

A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held on Thursday, March 31, 2016 at 4:15 p.m.

Present: Council Members Donny Anderson, Karen Ballinger, Jerry Fritz Landon Greer, Steve Miller, Stan Wolz and Barry Cook, City Administrator, and Cindy Baker, Administrative Services Officer.

Absent: Mayor Nancy Tia Brown

Council President Miller called the meeting to order at 4:15 p.m.

Cindy Baker, Administrative Services Officer provided the Governing Body with background information as it pertains to the liability insurance requirement for taxicabs and the information form the ordinance change in 2010. After some discussion, staff was directed to revise the ordinance to reflect \$500,000 and bring to a future council meeting for consideration.

Todd Stowell, City Planner provided the Governing Body with an ordinance revision pertaining to fences, as was previously requested at the Council Retreat. Staff was directed to put this ordinance on the Tuesday, April 5th agenda for first reading.

Todd Stowell, City Planner provided the Governing Body with an update on the Old Trail Town Sign that was destroyed recently with the high winds. The City has received a request from the adjacent property owner for the City to consider vacating that strip of land and has indicated his willingness to work with Old Trail Town on allowing the sign to remain. Staff has prepared an encroachment agreement to be utilized until the vacation process is complete. Staff was directed to put the encroachment agreement on the Tuesday, April 5th agenda for consideration.

Rick Manchester, Parks, Public Facilities and Recreation Director asked the Governing Body for direction as it pertains to the vacant office space in the Nichol Mall. Staff was directed to proceed with placing an ad in the local newspaper and signage in the window.

Leslie Brumage, Finance Officer provided the Governing Body with information pertaining to Municipal Court cost, collections, write offs etc. After some discussion it was decided the two council liaisons, the City Attorney, Municipal Court Judge and Chief Baker should review further once the new chief is on board. No action was taken.

The Governing Body reviewed the Tuesday, April 5th agenda. No action was taken.

There being no further discussion, the meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
