A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held in Council Chambers of City Hall in Cody, Wyoming on Thursday, February 2, 2012 at 4:10 p.m.

Mayor Nancy Tia Brown called the meeting to order at 4:17 p.m.

James Klessens with Forward Cody discussed with the Governing Body two projects that are moving forward and would be requesting the City to apply for Wyoming Business Council Grant Funds. The two projects included Wyoming Authentic Products and Rocky Mountain Granite. A public hearing will be advertised for both projects and will be heard at the February 21st Council meeting. No action was taken.

The Governing Body discussed the Special Funding Process. Staff was directed to follow the same process as in the previous years. No action was taken.

Steve Payne, Public Works Director provided the Governing Body with information regarding the National League of Cities Service Line Warranty Program. Staff was directed to research a variety of questions and bring the information back to the Council at the next work session. No action was taken.

Steve Payne, Public Works Director discussed the opportunity to purchase the “Nexgen” below grade slider bed feed Conveyor for the new Recycling Center, and discussed a budget transfer of \$17,950.00 between line items in the Solid Waste Budget to make the purchase. No action was taken.

The Governing Body discussed the agenda for the February 7, 2012 Council Meeting. No action was taken.
