Thursday, February 16, 2012

A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held in City Council Chambers at City Hall in Cody, Wyoming on Thursday, February 16, 2012 at 4:15 p.m.

Present: Council President, Steve Miller and Council Members Donny Anderson, Charles Cloud, Jerry Fritz and Bryan Edwards, City Attorney, Scott Kolpitke and City Administrator, Jenni Rosencranse

Council President Miller called the meeting to order at 4:15 p.m.

West Park Hospital CEO, Doug McMillan presented a power point slide show update on the West Park Hospital Modernization Project. It is anticipated that the project will be completed and the new portion of the hospital will be open in early June, 2012. He also provided information regarding the Spirit Mountain Hospice House, new doctors coming on board to West Park Hospital, the new Dialysis Unit at the Cathcart Building, and a software conversion throughout the hospital. No action was taken.

Leslie Brumage, Finance Officer discussed with the City Council the Banking Committee Recommendation to renew a one year contract with Wells Fargo for the City's Banking Services. Direction was given to staff to place a resolution on the agenda for the February 21, 2012 Council Agenda for approval to renew a one year agreement with Wells Fargo.

Leslie Brumage, Finance Officer discussed the Council Work Session Dates and it was determined that the dates will be May 21st, 22nd, and 23rd, 2012 from 4 to 6 p.m.

The City Council discussed Yellowstone National Park's new proposed alternatives for Sylvan Pass and over snow travel in the winter months. Direction was given to staff to have a draft letter prepared for the Council's review at the March 1, 2012 work session. No action was taken.

The City Council discussed the Agenda for February 21, 2012 Council Meeting. No action was taken.
