Council Proceedings
Thursday, July 28, 2016

A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held on Thursday, June 16, 2016 at 4:15 p.m.

Present: Mayor Nancy Tia Brown , Council Members Donny Anderson, Karen Ballinger, Jerry Fritz, Landon Greer, Steve Miller, Stan Wolz, Scott Kolpitcke, City Attorney and Cindy Baker, Administrative Services Officer.

Absent: None

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order at 4:15 p.m.

James Klessans, Forward Cody, provided the Governing Body with information as it relates to the BRC application for TCT and Cody Labs Substation projects. No action was taken.

Rick Manchester provided the Governing Body an update on the Recreation Center Day Care Services. Staff was directed, based on the information provided, to close the day care services as of August 1st.

The Governing Body discussed the holiday closures at the Recreation Center. Staff was given direction on the day after Thanksgiving and New Years. Staff was requested to provide more information to make a determination on the day after Christmas. No action was taken.

Rick Manchester, Parks, Facilities and Recreation Directed provided the Governing Body with an update as it related to the Cody Country Chamber Sanitary Sewer Issue. No action was taken.

Council Member Miller made a motion seconded by Council Member Wolz to authorize the Mayor to enter into and sign an agreement with the City of Cody and Safe Slide Restoration for the Recreation Center Water Slide Restoration Project, with funding not-to-exceed \$25,000 and funded by the Shoshone Recreation District. Vote was unanimous.

Barry Cook, City Administrator, provided the Governing Body with information as it related to a BRC- Community Enhancement Grant Application for the Chamber Buildings. Staff was directed to continue on this grant and provide the Council with an update or present at a future meeting for consideration.

Cindy Baker provided the Governing Body with information as it relates to Street Closure Events and Activities held during events. Staff was given direction on how to proceed with these items in the future.

The Governing Body reviewed the Agenda for the August 2nd Council Meeting. No action was taken.

There being no further discussion, the meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
