A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held in Council Chambers of Cody City Hall on Thursday, April 13, 2017 at 4:15 p.m.

Present: Mayor Matt Hall, Council Members Donny Anderson, Jerry Fritz, Karen Ballinger, and Stan Wolz, City Administrator, Barry Cook, and Leslie Brumage, Finance Officer/Deputy Clerk

Absent: Council Members Glenn A. Nielson and Landon Greer

Mayor Hall called the meeting to order at 4:15 p.m.

At 4:15 the Mayor entered in to a public hearing to consider if it is in the public's interest to consider adopting regulations pertaining to wireless communication facilities, to be located in Title 10, Zoning Regulations of the Municipal Code. Vote was unanimous. Council Member Ballinger made a motion seconded by Council Member Fritz to adopt Ordinance 2017-10 as amended on Third and Final Reading. Vote was unanimous.

Council Member Wolz made a motion seconded by Council Member Ballinger to authorize the request for FFA approval of agreement for transfer of entitlements and authorize the Mayor to sign said document as it relates to the Yellowstone Regional Airport. Vote was unanimous.

Council Member Wolz made a motion seconded by Council Member Anderson to authorize the Mayor to sign the grant agreement relating to the Design for the Expansion of the Apron at the Yellowstone Regional Airport. Vote was unanimous.

Council Member Wolz made a motion seconded by Council Member to authorize the Mayor to sign the grant agreement relating to the purchase of Misc. Land (6.27 acres Parcel 31) at the Yellowstone Regional Airport. Vote was unanimous.

The Governing Body discussed and reviewed the Conditions for Discharging Weapons within the City Limits as it relates to the Cody Gun Fighters Show for the summer 2017. Staff was directed to put this item on the agenda for Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup> for Council consideration. No action was taken

The Governing Body discussed a request from the Cody Skylighters as it relates the 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks show. Staff was directed to put this item on the agenda for Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup> for Council consideration. No action was taken.

The Governing Body discussed the utility rate increase on the electrical services. Staff was directed to put this item on the agenda for Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup> for Council consideration. No action was taken.

The Governing Body reviewed the April 18<sup>th</sup> agenda. No action was taken.
