Council Proceedings
Thursday, June 15, 2017

A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held in Council Chambers of Cody City Hall on Thursday, May 11, 2017 at 4:15 p.m.

Present: Mayor Matt Hall, Council Members Glenn A. Nielson, Jerry Fritz, Karen Ballinger, Landon Greer, Donny Anderson and Stan Wolz, City Administrator, Barry Cook, Scott Kolpitcke, City Attorney, and Administrative Services Officer, Cindy Baker

Mayor Hall called the meeting to order at 4:16 p.m.

The Governing Body discussed the Park County Fire District #2 New Policy for charging a fee for Commercial plan reviews, site inspections and testing compliance. Staff was provided with direction on how to proceed with this issue. No action was taken.

Council Member Wolz made a motion seconded by Council Member Anderson to approve a request for a street closure of 12th Street from Sheridan Avenue to the first alley south of Sheridan Avenue, from 5:30 PM to 6:45 PM, Monday through Saturday, June 16, 2017 through September 23, 2017 from the Wild Bunch Gunfighters. Approve the discharge of replica firearms. Noting event organizers will provide barricades, signage and personnel for set-up and tear-down. Approval conditional upon receipt of signed "Conditions for Discharging Weapons in the City for the Wild Bunch Gunfighter Summer 2017 Re-Enactment Shows" document, and the Certificate of Insurance as required. Vote was unanimous.

The Governing Body discussed and provided staff direction relating to subleasing space for cell tower on Riley Arena. No action was taken.

Ordinance 2017-13 Second Reading

An Ordinance providing for the amount of Tax Levy for the City of Cody, WY for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2018. Council Member Fritz made a motion seconded by Council Member Anderson to approve Ordinance 2017-13 on Second Reading. Vote was unanimous.

Ordinance 2017-14 Second Reading

An Ordinance providing for the annual appropriation of money for the maintenance of the City of Cody, WY for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2018. Council Member Ballinger made a motion seconded by Council Member Greer to approve Ordinance 2017-14 on Second Reading. Vote was unanimous.

The Governing Body discussed Planning & Zoning Board guidelines and issues or questions that have arisen over the past couple of years. No action was taken.

The Governing Body discussed Veteran's Memorial Park Committee. No action was taken.

The Governing Body discussed the recent updated Zoning Changes. Todd Stowell, City Planner, provided the Governing Body with an update on short term rentals. No action was taken.

There being no further discussion, Mayor Hall adjourned the meeting at 6:00 p.m.
