Dear City Council Members:

We are requesting to sell beer at the Concerts in the Park Series held on Thursday nights 6-8PM at City Park in Cody in July and August. We would want the YBF to be the head Non-Profit Organization in charge. We are looking to have different Non-Profit Organizations run the events. We will work with other Non-Profits to help them raise money. The Non-Profit would provide 2-4 volunteers. 100% of the proceeds raised from beer sales would go to that Non-Profit Organizations working that night.

We would purchase the necessary Malt Beverage for each day from the City of Cody. This allows us to buy beer from a brewery or Distributor. We only want to have one table with a canopy at the park. We do not want to have multiple tents scattered around selling beer. We are not trying to have a Beer Fest here. We just want to give people the option to enjoy a beer, and listen to music. While at the same time raising money for local charities. We have all the fencing, T-posts, canopy, garbage buckets, table etc. needed to run this event. Since we are raising money for local charities we would also ask that all fees be waived, except for the malt beverage permit. We would also provide Liability Insurance.
