A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held in Council Chambers of Cody City Hall on Monday, June 11, 2018 at 4:00 p.m.

ORDINANCE 2018-13 SECOND READING

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF MONEY FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY OF CODY, WYOMING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2019. Council Member made a motion seconded by Council Member Wolz to approve Ordinance 2018-13 on Second Reading. Vote was unanimous.

The Governing Body were reminded/informed of a vacancy on the Contractor Board. Staff was directed to advertise this opening with the normal process in late fall. No action was taken.

The Governing Body discussed Multi-Family Development and current ordinance/standards relating to this type of development. Staff will review and Planning & Zoning. No action was taken at this time.
