Tuesday, June 4, 2019

A pre-meeting was held at 6:50 p.m. to discuss the agenda for the Regular Meeting. No action was taken.

A regular meeting of the Cody City Council was held in the Council Chambers at City Hall in Cody, Wyoming on Tuesday, June 4, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

Present: Mayor Matt Hall, Council Members, Justin Baily, Diane Ballard, Landon Greer, Glenn Nielson and Heidi Rasmussen, City Attorney Scott Kolpitcke, City Administrator Barry Cook and Administrative Services Officer, Cindy Baker

Mayor Hall called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Proclamation – Mental Health Awareness

Council Member Greer made a motion seconded by Council Member Rasmussen to approve the Consent Calendar as amended including the approval of Minutes: Regular Minutes from May 21, 2019 and Special Work Session from May 14, 15 & 16, 2019; approve Vouchers and payroll in the amount of \$374,126.91 and approve the agreement between the City of Cody and Park County School District #6 and authorize the Mayor to sign the agreement. Vote was unanimous.

At 7:03 p.m. Mayor Hall called for a public hearing to consider if it is in the public's interest to approve a new restaurant liquor license for Brother's Three dba Chinatown located at 937 Sheridan Ave. Asking for comments three times and there being none at 7:06 p.m., Mayor Hall closed the public hearing.

Council Member Nielson made a motion seconded by Council Member Ballard to approve the restaurant liquor license for Brother's Three dba Chinatown located at 937 Sheridan Ave. Vote was unanimous.

Council Member made a motion seconded by Council Member to rescind the award of Bid 2019-04 19th Street Overlay Project to Wild West Construction. Council Member Greer recused himself from the vote. Voting favor were Council Members Nielson, Rasmussen, Ballard and Mayor Hall. Voting opposed were Council Members Fritz and Baily. Motion carried.

Council Member Fritz made a motion seconded by Council Member Greer to approve the preliminary plat of the Overfield Minor Subdivision, a 5-lot infill subdivision. Vote was unanimous.
