

**City of Cody
Council Proceedings
Thursday, May 2, 2013**

A special meeting of the Cody City Council was held in the Council Chambers at City Hall in Cody, Wyoming on Thursday, May 2, 2013 at 4:15 p.m.

Present: Mayor Nancy Tia Brown , Council Members Donny Anderson, Bryan Edwards, Jerry Fritz, Landon Greer, Steve Miller and Stan Wolz, Scott Kolpitzke, City Attorney City Administrator, Jenni Rosencranse, and Cindy Baker, Administrative Services Officer.

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order at 4:15 p.m.

Council Member Wolz made a motion seconded by Council Member to Anderson to approve the amended Final Plat for the Heart Mountain Condominiums Phase II on Kent Avenue as recommended by the Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board. Vote was unanimous.

Leah Bruscano, Director of Field Operations WBC provided the Governing Body with an overview of Wyoming Business Council Programs. No action was taken.

Steve Payne, Public Works Director provided the Governing Body with background information on the recent sewer lagoon study and discussed increasing the sewer base rate. Staff was directed to proceed with an ordinance.

Steve Payne, Public Works Director discussed a signage request between old Library and Moose Creek Inn. Staff was directed to bring this to the Council as an action item for the next regular meeting to be held on May 7th.

Steve Payne, Public Works Director provided an update on parking on 19th Street and Salsbury since changed from parallel to diagonal in front of the Four Square Church. Since there has been no traffic incidents or concerns brought forth, staff was directed to continue to stripe as diagonal parking.

Jenni Rosencranse, City Administrator discussed the 2013 WAM Resolutions that will be addressed at the June convention and encourage Council to relay their comments to the City's Voting delegate.

Rick Manchester, Parks, Public Facilities and Recreation Director discussed the City property in the Chugwater Rims Subdivision. Staff was directed to move forward with the process to sale this parcel.

Jenni Rosencranse, City Administrator discussed the LEC contract. Staff was directed to present to the Governing Body as an action item at an upcoming Council meeting.

Governing Body reviewed Council Agenda for May 7, 2013. No action was taken.

There being no further discussion, the meeting adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
