Residential and commercial dumpsters will be picked up prior to Thursday.

Residential and commercial dumpsters will be picked up between Thursday,
December 26 & Friday, December 27.

Wednesday, January 1, 2014

Residential and commercial dumpsters will be picked up between Thursday,
January 2 & Friday, January 3.

Large Item Pick-Up

In an effort to maintain the beauty of our City, the City of Cody will begin another season of the Large Item Pick-Up (LIP) and Tree & Brush Removal Programs to Cody's residential customers. These programs have replaced the Spring and Fall clean-up. A fee is often assessed with these services, however, the City of Cody will not be charging a fee for these services at this time. It is our hope that providing these services will aid in keeping our alleys and streets free of unsightly debris as well as to provide a helpful service to the City of Cody residents.

- 1). Each resident is allowed one pick-up per month per address. Tree limbs and brush pick-up will be on Tuesdays and other large item pick-ups are typically collected on Thursdays.
- 2). To schedule and request a pick-up of specified large items that cannot be placed inside a dumpster or rollout, tree limbs and brush please call the City at 587-2958 or 527-7511. LIP is limited to 2 cubic yards (equal to approximately one level pickup load) per pick-up.
- 3). In order to make these programs successful, there are a few guidelines to follow:

- * Items must be placed next to the curb in front of your residence. Items cannot block any other resident's driveway or impede traffic. For residents who do not have curb and gutter, items may be placed at the edge of the pavement.

- * All items must be stacked separately and set out before 7:00 AM on the scheduled pick-up day and must not be set out any earlier than 24 hours prior.

Tree & Brush Removal

This program will be handled separately from LIP. From November 1 through March 31 residential customers who have tree limbs (less than 10" in diameter) and brush piles to dispose of may contact the City at 587-2958 or 527-7511 to schedule a pick-up of these items. This material will be chipped and used in the City's landscaping of parks and public facilities. Each pick-up is limited to piles that are no larger than 8'W x 10'L x 10'H.

Tree limbs and brush must be stacked, on the street, parallel to the curb, in an orderly fashion with all cut ends facing one direction. Brush and limbs should NOT be tied together. All limbs and brush must be out before 7:00 AM on Tuesday. Please ensure that there is adequate parking space on either side of the brush pile. Removal of materials over 10" in diameter is the responsibility of the property owner.

Programs Begin November 1 & ends March 31 for Cody Residential Customers

Snow Removal

Cody's Snow and Ice Control Plan is designed to keep traffic moving through and within the city as safely as possible during inclement winter weather. Snow plowing services are prioritized, beginning with Priority 1 Routes, followed by Priority 2 Routes and then Priority 3 Routes. The Streets Division maintains approximately 77 miles of streets within the Cody city limits.
