ASAP is based out of the Paul Stock Aquatic & Recreation Center MONDAY through FRIDAY afternoons. Youth have access to a variety of amenities & activities each day, including swimming on Tuesdays & Fridays.

WHO: Kindergarten to 6th Graders

WHAT: Wactivities, Homework help, swimming (Tue & Fri) & other fun events!

WHEN: School dismissal until 6 P. NO ASAP when Rec is closed.

WHERE: Tiny Tots room in the Rec Center.

COST: Prepay with punchcards; \$8.50/day or \$160 for 20 days. Snack & supplies are provided

TRANSPORTATION: From Livingston #5 bus (Lizard) & from Sunset/Eastside #31 bus (Squirrel).

REGISTRATION: Packets are required for each child prior to attending.

At ASAP we have expectations & boundaries to ensure everyone feels comfortable & safe. Our ASAP rules are based on the Home Court Advantage with both physical & emotional components. Our Home Court Advantage is outlined & explained daily. Students are expected to follow HCA rules at all times

SAFETY

Safety is our #1 rule!

Physically, we will stay inside the Recreation Center & always within sight of an ASAP teacher. In order to use the bathroom or move throughout the building, we must have permission & update our "X Marks My Spot" sheet or be accompanied by a teacher. We will use safety when playing with each other & supplies such as scissors, hot glue, etc. Also, cell phone usage is limited to the ASAP phone for emergencies only & with staff help.

Emotionally, we also will be safe with each other's feelings, beliefs & ideas.

ASAP Daily Schedule M-TH:

Bus arrival to 3:50 - Check in/Gym Play
3:50 to 4:10 Circle time & Snack
4:10 to 5:15 Stations (HomeFUN, classroom play, gym play, swimming (W/F), Wack (craft/science/etc.)
5:15 to 6 Classroom play

ADDITIONAL PROGRAM DETAILS

Bus transportation is provided by the school district to the Rec Center each school day. Students should ride *bus #31, the SQUIRREL bus, from SUNSET & EASTSIDE SCHOOLS or bus #5, the LIZARD bus, from LIVINGSTON.*
