**WHO:** Kindergarten to 6th Graders

**WHAT:** Wactivities, Homework help, swimming (Tue & Fri) & other fun events!

**WHEN:** School dismissal until 6 P. NO ASAP when Rec is closed.

**WHERE:** Tiny Tots room in the Rec Center.

**COST:** Prepay with punchcards; \$8.50/day. Snack & supplies are provided

**KIDS ARE TRANSPORTED** from Livingston #5 bus (Lizard) & from Sunset/Eastside #31 bus (Squirrel).

**REGISTRATION:** Packets are required for all children prior to attending.


# OUR HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Physically, we will value each other's property & possessions. This includes students & staff. We also value our space at the Rec Center & take care of these areas & supplies.


Emotionally, we value each other's ideas, feelings, background, experiences, etc.
